



Decorate this crown for a king.



John 12:1-8






Notice smells in worship today—flowers, bread, wine, incense, perfume.

What songs did you sing in worship today? What were some of the important words in each song?



A Lenten Prayer


The symbol of Lent is a cross. Try to think of a prayer with 12 words in it. Write one word on each side of the cross.




Fill the words of the memory verse into the blank crossword puzzle.







Lent 5
