

Jesus taught many people in Samaria. They believed he was Christ, the one sent to bring God's word to all.




Wilderness wandering

The Israelites followed Moses through the wilderness. They were very thirsty for **b** but they didn't trust God to provide what they needed. Instead they complained to Moses.






