

Jesus is the Good Shepherd. He knows our names, cares for us, and looks for us when we're lost. Jesus is always with us.


Search the valley for 23 hidden sheep. (Can you find more?) What do you think their names might be?

What kinds of flowers do you see growing outside? Draw these flowers in the flower pots below.






- Today is the 4th Sunday in Easter.

Shepherds spent every hour of their day watching, tending, protecting,



- Spring is a season of **new life**.


Baa! Baa! So many shepherds in this picture! Can you find the Good Shepherd? Circle him.
